# THE HOUSING FOR ALL LAND TRUST (HALT)?

Land trusts are an internationally proven vehicle to generate and retain affordable housing. As such, a new ecosystem of community land trusts is starting to emerge across Canada.

HALT will unlock and preserve deeply a ffordable housing by acquiring properties and collaborating with non-profit housing operators to provide access to support services for those who need it.

Affordable housing units are being removed from communities faster than they are being built.














### OVERVIEW

In 2024, more than 80,000 people in Ontario were homeless, a 24% increase since 2022. The Association of Municipalities of Ontario estimates that 75,000 affordable and supportive housing units need to be created to address the increasing demand for stable housing for those in needs. These statistics highlight the critical needs for comprehensive and sustained efforts to address housing stability and affordability in Ontario.



## HALT has the potential to create a lasting impact in the housing system.



The land trust will create and preserve affordable housing.

- Creating new housing across the spectrum of community housing, including supportive and affordable rental housing.
- Raising and deploying capital to enable new development and preservation/renewal of existing affordable housing.
- Maintaining assets as affordable in perpetuity.





The land trust will achieve greater scale and sustainability in the community housing sector

- Model a sustainable growth
   engine that increases the
   capacity of human resources
   dedicated to the growth of
   community -owned affordable
   housing, reducing duplication
   of efforts across the sector.
- Ensure the professional management of assets for term sustainability.





## We need help from Ontario municipalities to realize our mission.


The land trust is looking to collaborate with municipalities and other levels of government to realize housing opportunities for those in greatest need across the province.
