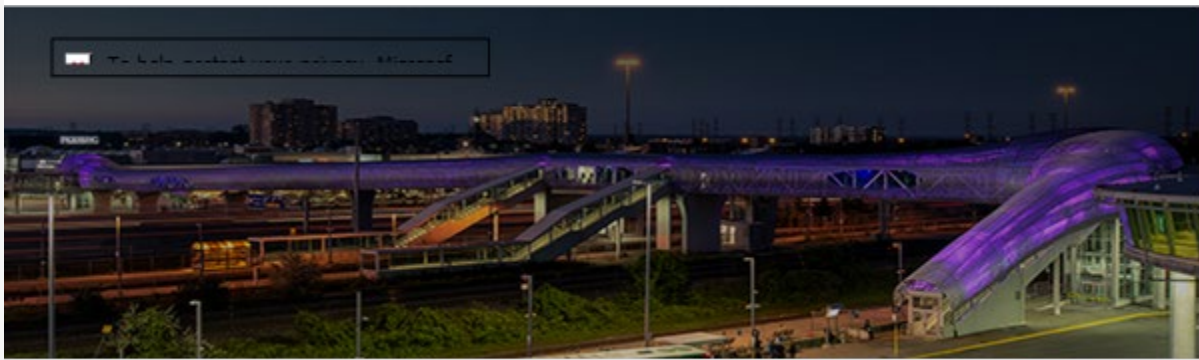

On Saturday, September 20 and Sunday, September 21, GO train service on Lakeshore East will be adjusted due to planned construction. GO buses will replace train service between Durham College Oshawa and Pickering GO stations. Lakeshore East GO train service will run between Pickering GO and Union Station.

In addition, some late night trains on Friday, Sept. 19 will also be adjusted.

If you regularly connect with GO bus route 88 (Oshawa-Peterborough), your connection time may change, and you may need to travel on an earlier trip to arrive at your destination on time.

All customers are encouraged to plan their trip in advance and sign up for on the GO alerts to be notified of any planned or unplanned service adjustments, delays, cancellations, or improvements.
